The Doctor of Medical Science (DMSc) program for Physician Assistants (PAs) is designed to build a depth of knowledge and skill to advance clinical practice, with the goal of providing experienced PAs the flexibility to enhance their knowledge holistically and focus study in a topic of their choosing and interest.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- No GRE Required
- Official transcripts from all former institutions
- Statement detailing a practice-based issue or problem you are interested in improving
- 3 letters of recommendation
- CV/Resume
- NCCPA Certification, current and active
- Current Licensure in the US, preference for regional licensure- MD, DC, DE, VA and PA
- MS or BS with PA certification and a minimum of 2 years clinical experience or graduation from an accredited post graduate residency
- Graduates of the PA master's program may be eligible for up to 15 credits toward the DMSc, leaving only 45 credits left to completion
